Goal

- To support ambitious teaching practices that enhances student thinking and learning through talk

Benefits

- **By participating in this project**, delivered by nationally recognized science education researchers and PD experts, **teachers will come away with a collection of resources, materials, and activities** that they can immediately use in their classrooms

- Teachers will be randomly assigned to 1 of 3 groups and will engage in a year-long PD and research study that includes:

- 36 hrs of summer PD: **\$750/teacher/6 days**

Group 1: **June 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, and 15, 2021**

Group 2: **June 22, 23, 24, 25, 28, and 29, 2021**

Group 3: **June 2022**

- 2021/2022 In-school PD: **Group 1 & 2 = \$750/teacher**
Group 3 = \$250/teacher

- 2020/2021: **Teacher surveys only = \$100/teacher**
